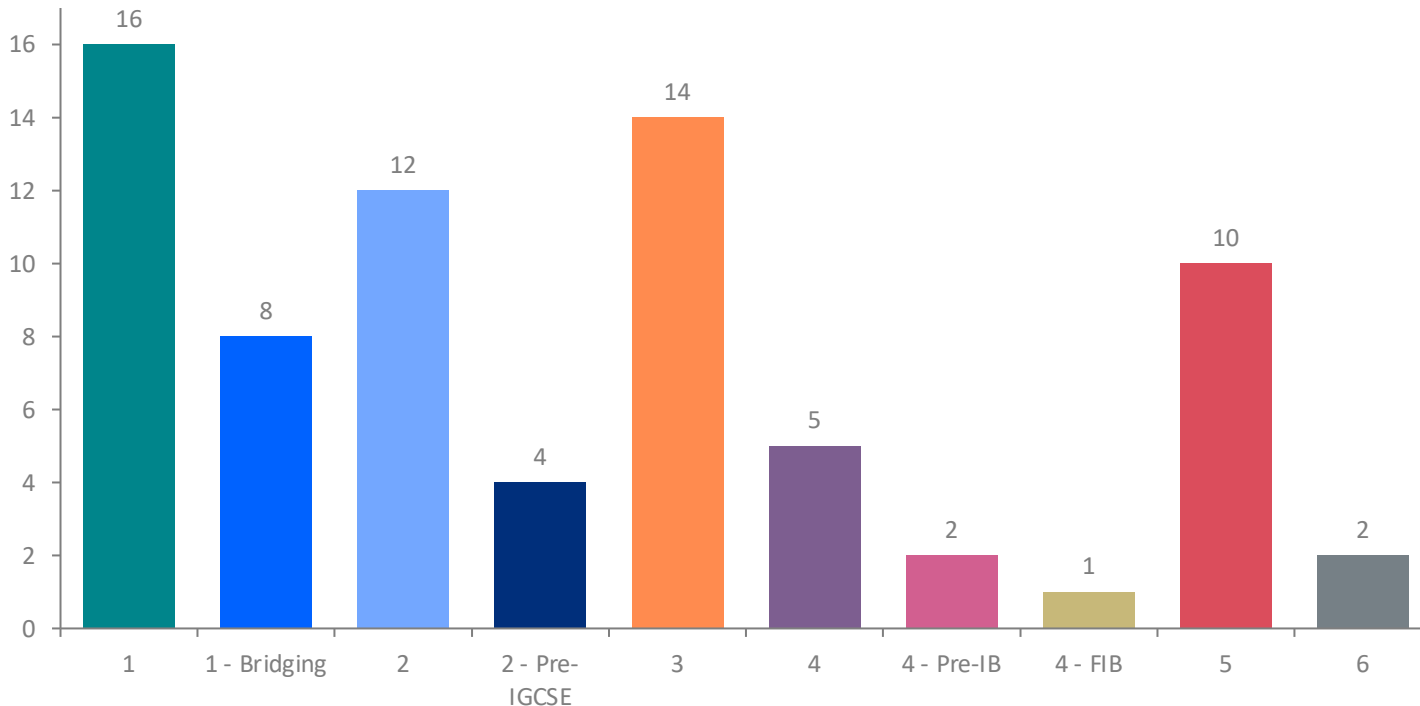

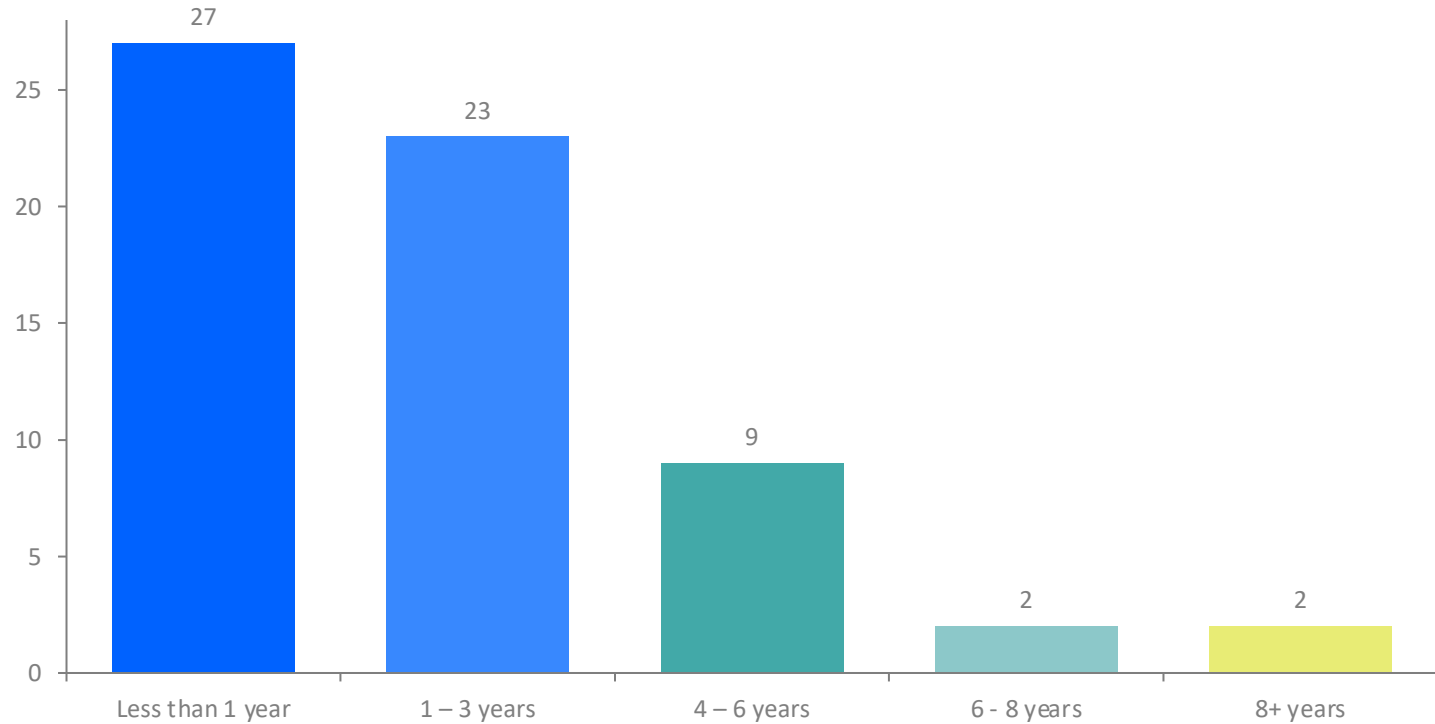

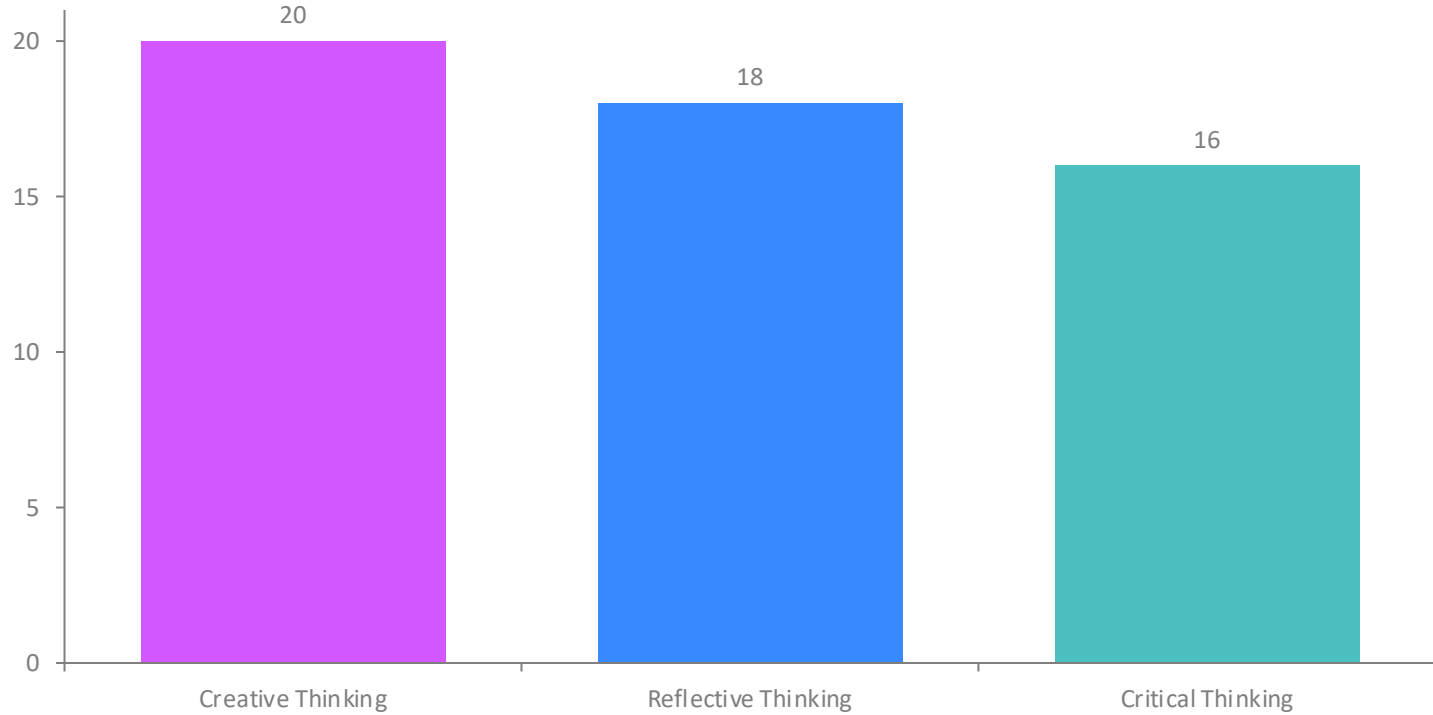

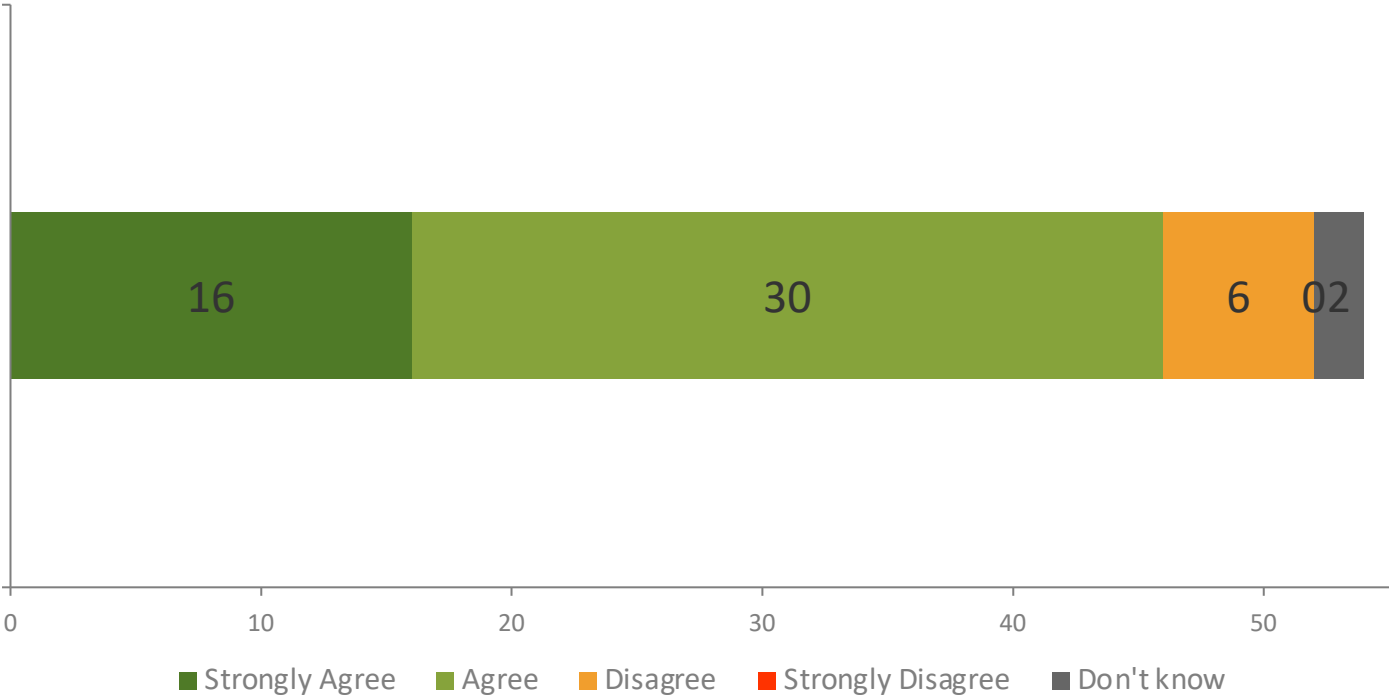
## Q24: Please pick which type of thinking you believe your child is strongest in.

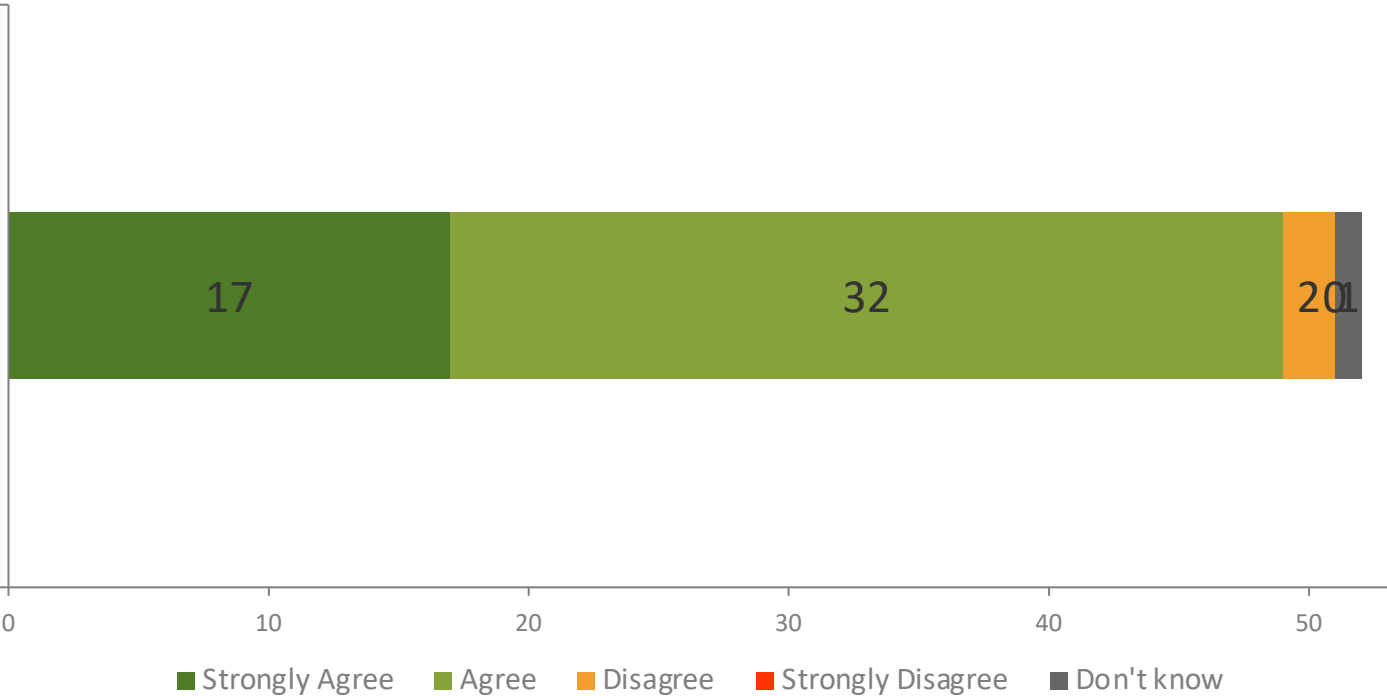

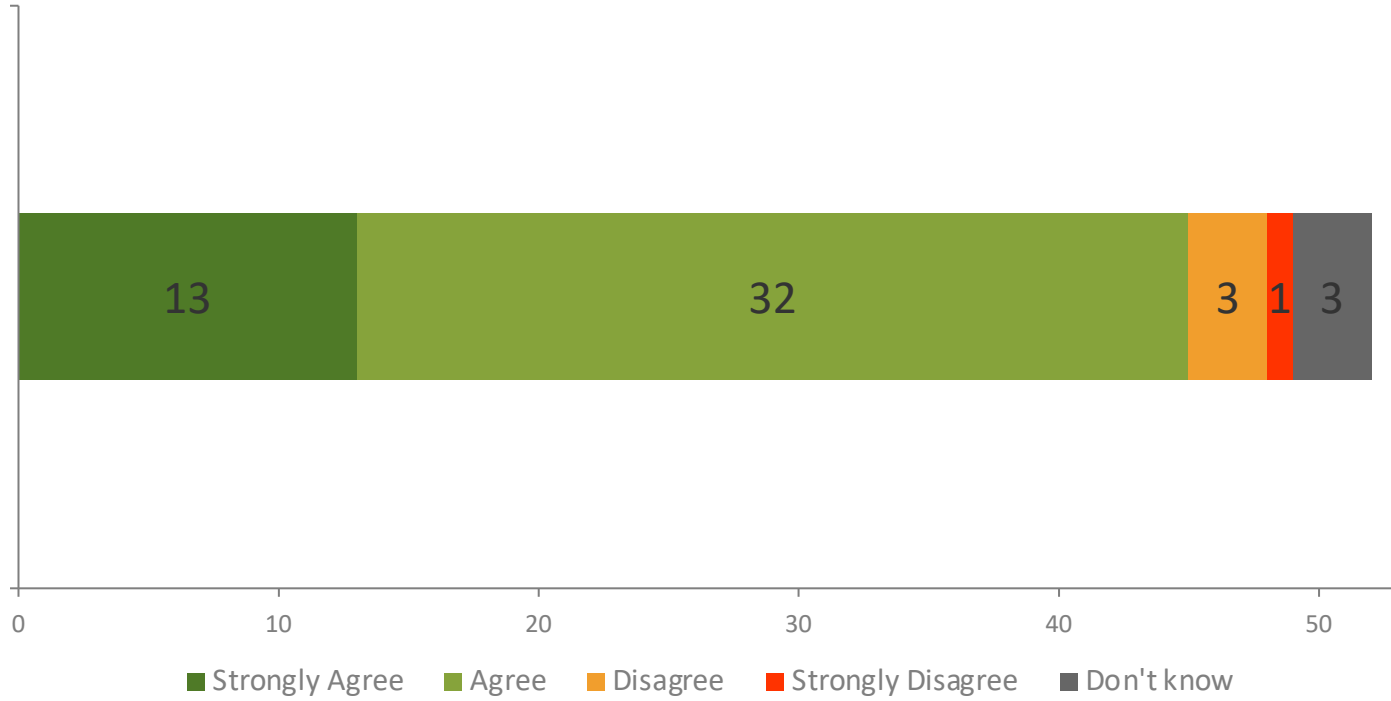

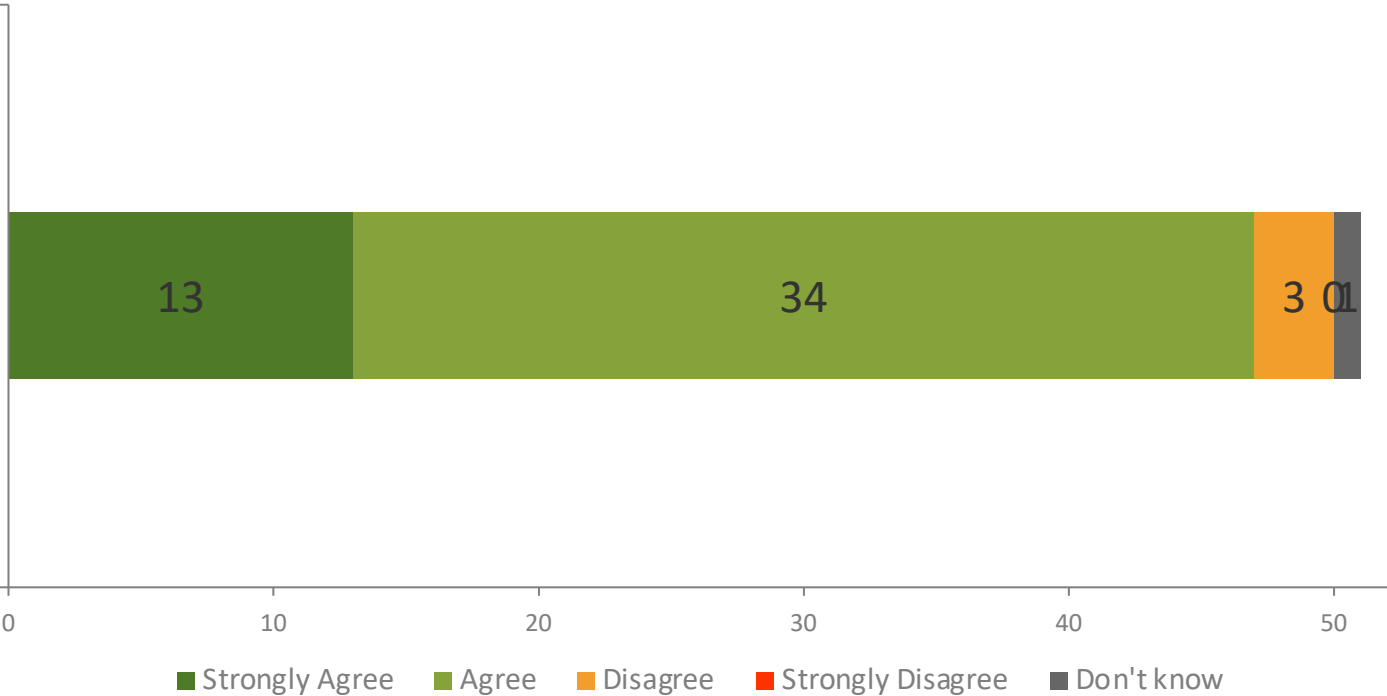

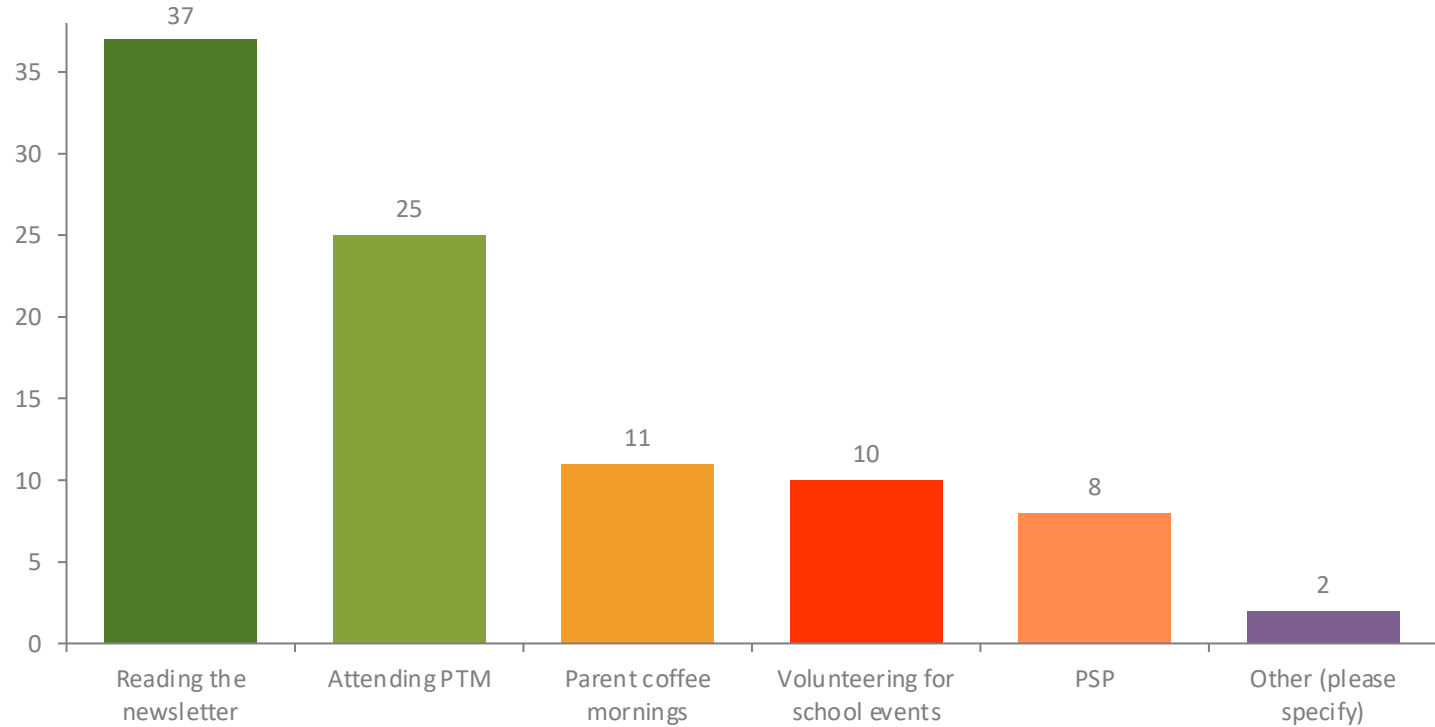
