What are the aims of the CCA programme?

At ACS (International), our Co-Curricular Activities (CCA) aim to **nurture all-round student development** by offering a wide range of sports, arts and interest group activities. These activities help students to realise and fulfill their potential outside of the academic field.

Our CCA programme also encourages International Mindedness and Global Citizenship by providing opportunities for students to engage in activities that promote empathy, inclusivity, and mental health awareness, both locally and globally. Through these experiences, students not only develop their talents but also cultivate a deeper understanding of the world, preparing them to be compassionate, responsible global citizens.



What is different about the CCA programme at ACS (International)?

In contrast to a traditional CCA programme (typically offered in MOE schools), CCAs at ACS (Int) are scheduled in a way that allows, and encourages, students to express themselves in a variety of different contexts.

- Students can engage in multiple CCAs throughout the year and are free to change their CCAs annually if they wish.
- The Art & Interest groups CCAs run continuously throughout the year, whereas the Sports CCAs run on a seasonal basis.
- All CCAs are free at the point of entry (students may need to purchase specific equipment/attire or pay for events such as trips or excursions).



What are the expectations?

School Expectations

- Maintain excellent levels of attendance, with a minimum of 70% for CCA to be recorded in End-of-Year report.
- Approach the CCA with enthusiasm and proactivity, consistently putting forth their best effort.
- Take on leadership roles within CCA to foster personal growth and responsibility.

Student Expectations

- CCAs will be fun, engaging and progressive
- Access to high-quality resources, support, and competition.
- Achievements will be celebrated and recognised within the school.
- Students will have opportunities for leadership within their CCAs.



What else do I need to know?

- Students are required to participate in at least one CCA throughout the year (Year 4 and Year 6 students may be exempted from CCAs in Semester 2).
- The school manages the CCA programme through the "SchoolsBuddy" platform. Students and parents can only sign-up for CCAs using their SchoolsBuddy account. All sign-up confirmation, allocation, attendance and CCA communications will be done through this platform. (more information on SchoolsBuddy will be provided at the end of this presentation)
- Students that are invited to join school leadership groups such as school prefects, student council, sports council and ambassadors can use this commitment as a CCA equivalent (please note that these groups are not available for CCA sign-ups)



Key Dates

- Thursday 16th January: Virtual CCA Fair Presentation in House Tutor rooms. Art and Interest Group CCA sign-ups open on SchoolsBuddy at 8:30am.
- Tuesday 21st January 12pm: Arts and Interest Group CCA sign-ups close on SchoolsBuddy.
 Students and parents should finalise their choices and submit before this deadline.
- Thursday 23rd January: CCA allocation process is finalised. Confirmed CCA allocations sent out for Arts and Interest Groups.
- Monday 3rd February: CCAs begin for Arts and Interest Groups.
- Monday 5th February: Sports CCA sign-ups open for ACSIS Season 3.
- 24th-28th February: Sports trials week for ACSIS Season 3.

Students who wish to amend their CCA after allocation must approach the relevant CCA Head. Amendments will be on a case by case, subject to availability.






Math Club (NEW CCA)

We will be launching the Hyrox Training Club as a new CCA for students (Year 4-6) during ACSIS Season 3 (3rd Mar- 9th May)!



External CCAs


Students who currently train regularly outside of school can register their activity as an External Sports CCA.

Using SchoolsBuddy at ACS (International)



A Student & Parent Guide



What is SchoolsBuddy?

SchoolsBuddy is a comprehensive school activities management software for staff, students and parents.

It is designed to help schools with the management and communication of a variety of administrative tasks for CCAs, Events, Trips and much more...





How can I access SchoolsBuddy?



New app icon for SchoolsBuddy 2.0.

To access SchoolsBuddy you must first activate your account;

- 1. Check your email- Students check your <u>school email/</u>
 Parents check the <u>contact email address</u> that you have provided to the school.
- 2. Follow the instructions within the email to activate your SchoolsBuddy account.
- **3. Download the "SchoolsBuddy 2.0." app** on either iOS or Android. Or visit https://acsinternational.schoolsbuddy.net/
- 4. Sign in with your newly created account details.
- 5. Remember to allow notifications.



When students and parents access SchoolsBuddy the first thing you will see will be a "Welcome Message", a short message outlining current status of the CCA programme.

SchoolsBuddy refers to "containers" when talking about activities and CCAs. A container is just a term for an area that holds all of the CCAs of a similar type in once place. Once the CCA Sign-ups are opened you will see multiple containers that are available for students and parents to make their CCA selections.

Hint: Where a CCA activity is not self-explanatory, check the 'description' on Schools Buddy to find out about what the CCA is about.




- Click the 'Activities & Clubs' tab
- Click on either "Sports CCAs" or "Art and Interest Group CCAs" containers by selecting the "Choose" button which will look similar to the image on the right.
- From there, the CCAs that are available to a student will be shown by day of the week.
- Click the day of the week to expand the section.
- Select preferences for each club for the desired day of the week.





- SchoolsBuddy uses a preference-based system to fairly allocate CCA choices.
- Within your container choose your top 3 preferences for your CCAs. Ranking 1st, 2nd, 3rd.
- *Required a minimum of 2 CCAs selection.
- If you do not choose a 2nd or 3rd choice, you risk not being allocated a CCA at all.





•Once preferences have been selected, students click the blue <u>'Review & Confirm'</u> button which can be found at the top right of the screen.



- After reviewing selections made students should click 'COMPLETE and Send ALL to School'.
- Students will then receive an email confirming that the selections have been received.
- When the School has the processed the CCA allocations, students will receive a further email communication showing which CCA each student has been allocated or not allocated.
- The student's Diary will be automatically populated with the time and date of the events of the CCAs the have been allocated.
- The teacher's Diary will also automatically populate with all scheduled CCA slots.
